75°	94°	109°
80°	99°	114°
85°	104°	119°
90°	109°	124°
95°	114°	129°

Even in the shade, the temperature in the car can still soar quickly to **dangerous levels.**

Leaving the windows open has **little effect** on how hot it is inside the car.
